The Cook County 9-1-1 System also filed a plan modification opting the Village of Stone Park out of its 911 system to Proviso-Leyden.

Proviso-Leyden is also requesting to change its backup PSAP to the Cicero 9-1-1 Center. The Cicero 9-1-1 Center meets all the requirements for a backup PSAP as prescribed in Section 1325.415(i) of Illinois Administrative Code Part 1325 - Standards of Service Applicable to 9-1-1 Emergency Systems as it is currently the primary PSAP in the Cicero 9-1-1 System.
