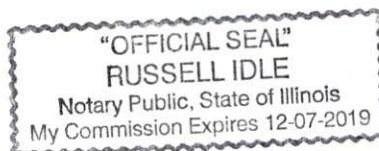

Plan Narrative:

Knox County residents with a North Henderson telephone number (309-464-XXXX) are currently served by Frontier Communications through the Mercer County exchange. Mercer County E911 is transitioning providers to INdigital and Geneseo Communications. Geneseo Communications has no infrastructure currently in place to route calls to Knox County's LEC of CenturyLink. All research to date has shown only one customer will be affected by the change in service providers. Therefore, Mercer County and Knox County will establish an intergovernmental agreement that Mercer County 9-1-1 will answer 9-1-1 calls for service from residents with a North Henderson exchange telephone number and then transfer the call to Knox County using the existing ten-digit transfer to 309-345-3721.



Please return this letter no later than December 15, 2018. The information will be submitted to the Illinois State Police as part of a modification application concerning the North Henderson exchange traffic.

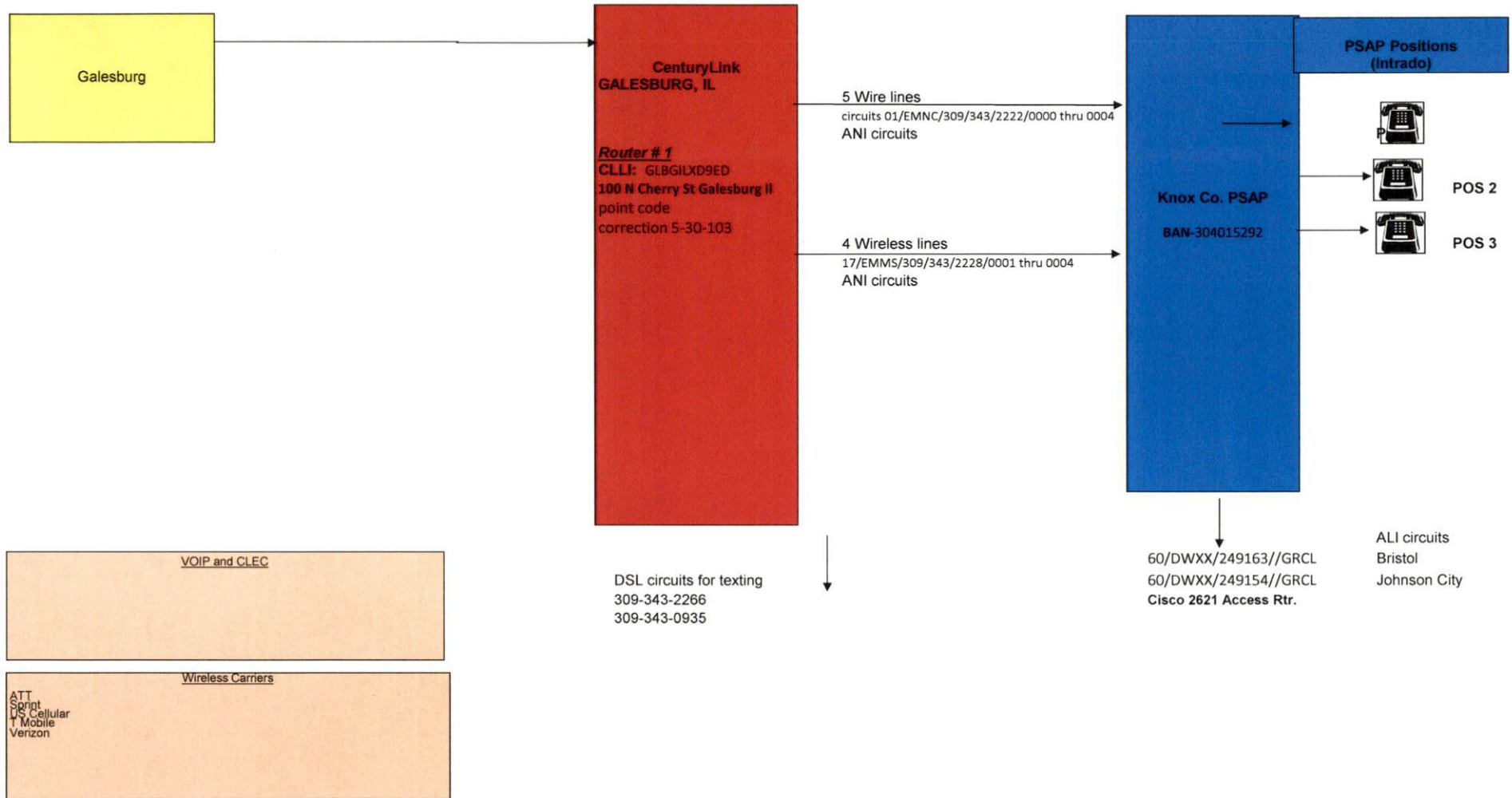
