All 9-1-1 calls for Park Ridge will be directed to Cook County's 9-1-1 system. An IGA has been entered into relating to the transfer and reporting of surcharge funds attributable to the City of Park Ridge which previously had an ETSB before joining WSCDC. Any funds attributable to Park Ridge will be transferred to the Cook County ETSB including any surcharge funds collected after Park Ridge becomes a member of the Cook County ETSB. Wireless surcharge will also be transferred to the Cook County ETSB going forward once a wireless plan is filed and approved.
