### Law Enforcement Employment Information

In 2017, 376 Illinois law enforcement agencies submitted law enforcement employment data presented in this section. Data consists of the number of part- and full-time sworn officers, full-time civilian employees, and auxiliary officers employed by each reporting agency as of October 31, 2017. The part- and full-time sworn officer category includes the number of sworn personnel with full arrest powers (includes chiefs, sheriffs, commissioners, superintendents, etc.) who are paid by their agency or federal grant funds. The full-time civilian category includes civilian employees (clerks, stenographers, telecommunicators, mechanics, civilian jail personnel, sworn jail personnel with no arrest power outside of the jail, etc.) who are paid by their agency or federal grant funds. The auxiliary officer category includes those officers, such as an auxiliary or reserve officer, who are subject to report in an emergency situation, and who are not paid by their agency or federal grant funds. Auxiliary officers paid by their agency or federal grant funds are accounted for under the part-time sworn officer category.

The employment rate for law enforcement personnel is calculated as follows:

$$\frac{\text{Number of Employees}}{\text{Jurisdictional Population}} \times 1,000 = \text{Employment Rate}$$

**EXAMPLE:**

A department with 60 employees and a population of 51,000 has an employment rate of 1.2 per 1,000 inhabitants:

$$\frac{60}{51,000} \times 1,000 = 1.2 \text{ Rate per 1,000 Inhabitants}$$

Law enforcement employment rates should not be directly compared to index crimes, non-index offenses, or the service-related activities performed by law enforcement officers. Service-related activities can account for a significant percentage of an officer’s workload on any given day, and usually remain unpublished. Each community should consider all the factors related to the causes of crime and determine the role of the law enforcement department relative to crime and to required services.

## 2017 Law Enforcement Employment Information

The total number of personnel as reported by 376 Illinois law enforcement agencies in 2017 is 37,131 employees. An aggregate population of 7,995,854 is represented by the 376 reporting agencies. The resulting employment rate is 4.6 law enforcement employees per 1,000 inhabitants. Reporting agencies include municipal police departments, miscellaneous police departments (airports, colleges and universities, fire department arson investigators, forest preserves, park districts, and railroads), sheriffs' offices, and statewide law enforcement agencies.

The 25,215 full-time sworn officers in 2017 account for 67.9 percent of the reporting agencies' law enforcement work force. The 1,221 part-time sworn officers employed in 2017 comprise 3.3 percent of the reporting agencies' law enforcement work force. The 10,139 full-time civilians in 2017 account for 27.3 percent of the reporting agencies' law enforcement work force. The 556 auxiliary officers employed in 2017 account for 1.5 percent of the reporting agencies' law enforcement work force.

In the tables on the following pages, the number of employees and population for each reporting agency is provided to allow for the calculation to determine the employment rate per 1,000 inhabitants. Miscellaneous police departments and statewide law enforcement agencies do not have a population and employment rates cannot be calculated for these agencies.
