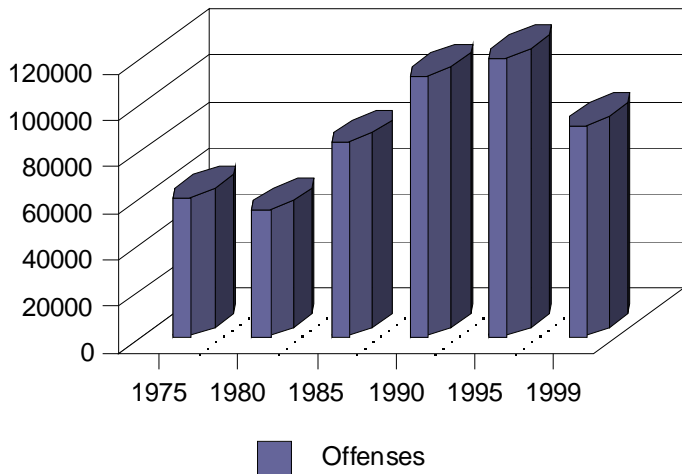


SECTION I - CRIME TRENDS

Crime Trends A Historical Perspective

This historical information is intended to provide a more comprehensive perspective in crime trends. These graphs illustrate the general trend in crimes reported in Illinois. For ease of interpretation, the total crimes reported is shown for every fifth year. These “fifth-year” patterns largely reflect the general trends.

Violent Crime Total



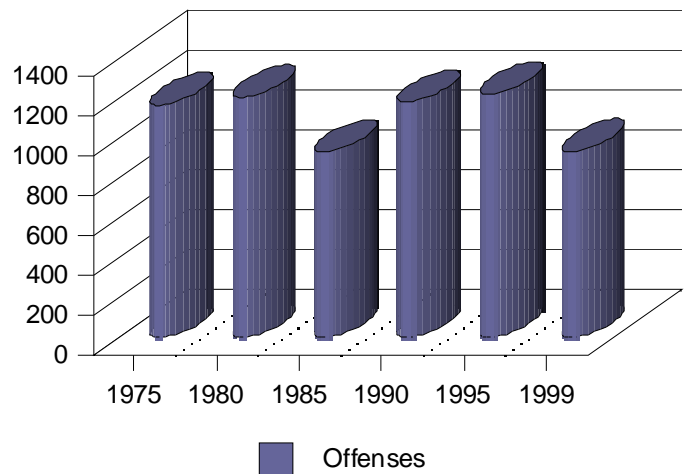
Violent crime offenses consist of Murder, Criminal Sexual Assault, Robbery and Aggravated Assault/Aggravated Battery. The highest number of violent crimes reported was in 1994 with a total of 126,101. 1977 is on record as the year with the lowest reported violent crimes - a total of 48,930 offenses. The largest percent increase occurred in 1984 - a 33.4% increase from 1983. The largest percent decrease occurred in 1976 - a 14.8% decrease from 1975. Violent crimes account for less than 20% of the crime index total.

During 1999, a total of 90,870 violent crimes was reported, reflecting a 9.4% decrease from the 100,244 violent crimes reported in 1998.

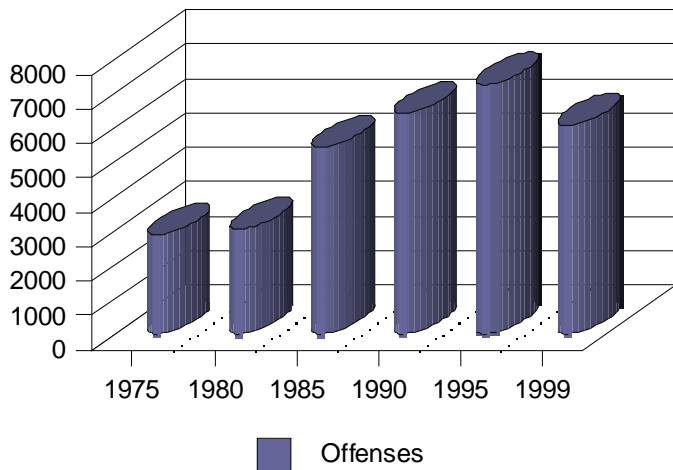
The highest number of murder offenses reported in a single year was 1,380 (in 1994), while 1985 is on record as the year with the lowest number of murders - 935. The largest percent increase occurred in 1973 with a 19.3% increase from 1972. The year 1982 showed the largest percent decrease - 18.4% fewer murders than 1981. Murders account for 1.0% of the violent crimes total and 0.2% of the total crime index offenses.

During 1999, a total of 937 murders was reported, reflecting a 7.9% decrease from the 1,017 murders reported in 1998.

Criminal Sexual Assault



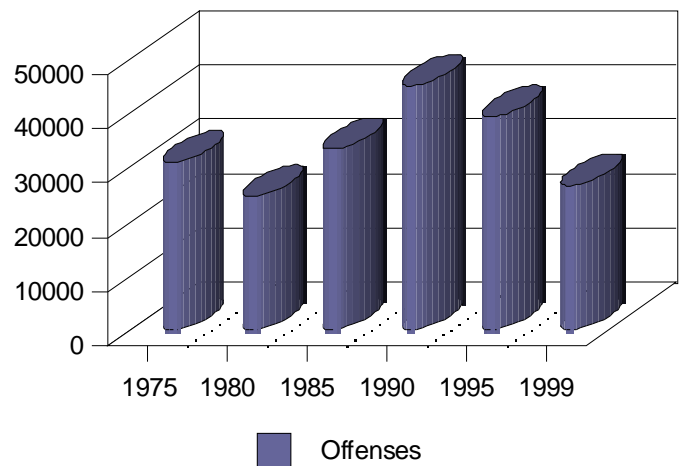
The reported number of Criminal Sexual Assault (formerly Rape 1975-1980) offenses increased each year from 1983 through 1993, with the largest number of offenses (7,620) reported in 1993. Offenses reported decreased each year from 1994 through 1999. The largest percent increase occurred in 1983 with a 49.4% increase from 1982. The largest percent decrease occurred in 1976 with a 16.9% decrease from 1975.

During 1999, a total of 6,062 criminal sexual assaults was reported, reflecting a 1.8% decrease from the 6,174 offenses reported in 1998.

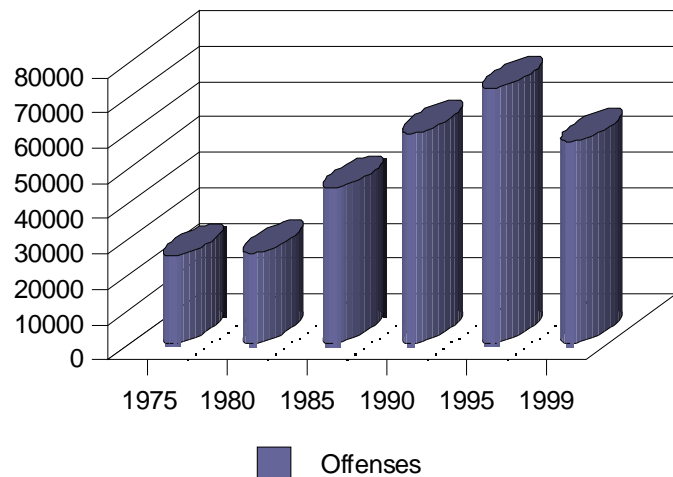
Robbery

The reported number of Robbery offenses increased the most in 1983 - a 29.5% increase from 1982. The largest percent decrease occurred in 1976 with a 20.4% decrease from 1981. 1991 reported the most number of offenses with 52,486, while 1979 reported the least amount - 22,060.

During 1999, a total of 26,644 robberies was reported, reflecting an 11.6% decrease from the 30,229 offenses reported in 1998.



Aggravated Assault/Battery

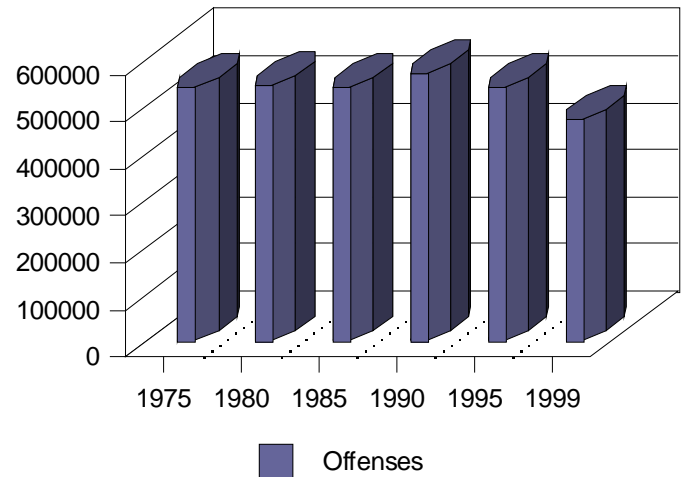


Aggravated Assault/Aggravated Battery reported offenses have increased every year from 1978 through 1991 (with the exception of 1981 and 1985) and decreased every year from 1995 through 1999. The year 1984 reflected the largest percent increase of 55.5% from 1983. The largest percent decrease occurred in 1981 with a 13.1% decrease from 1980. The most number of offenses reported in one year occurred in 1994 with a total of 74,113 offenses. The year with the least reported offenses was 1977 with a total of 21,717 offenses.

During 1999, a total of 57,227 offenses was reported, reflecting an 8.9% decrease from the 62,824 offenses reported in 1998.

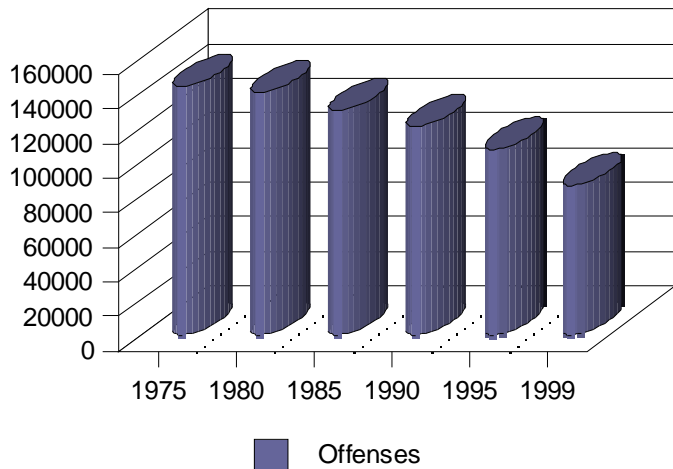
Property Crime Total

Property Crimes consist of Burglary, Theft (including Burglary from Motor Vehicle), Motor Vehicle Theft and Arson. The most number of property crimes was reported in 1991 - 586,629 offenses. The least number of property crimes was reported in 1972 - 373,469 offenses. The largest percent increase occurred in 1974 with an 18.3% increase from 1973. The largest percent decrease occurred in 1992 with a 9.7% decrease from 1991. Property crimes account for over 83% of the crime index total.



During 1999, a total of 469,666 property crime offenses was reported, reflecting a 7.5% decrease from the 507,847 offenses reported in 1998.

Burglary



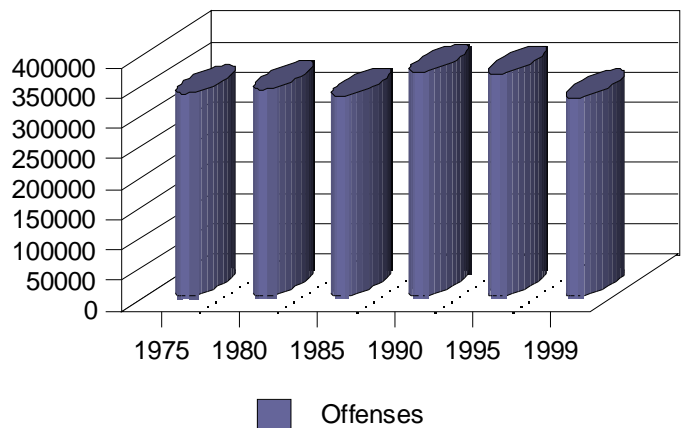
Burglary offenses decreased every year from 1981 through 1999 with the exception of 1983, 1986, and 1991. The most burglary offenses reported in a given year was reported in 1980 with a total of 139,940 offenses. The largest percent increase occurred in 1974 with a 20.9% increase from 1973. The largest percent decrease occurred in 1973 with a 21.1% decrease from 1972.

During 1999, a total of 86,390 burglary offenses was reported, reflecting an 11.7% decrease from the 97,792 offenses reported in 1998.

Theft

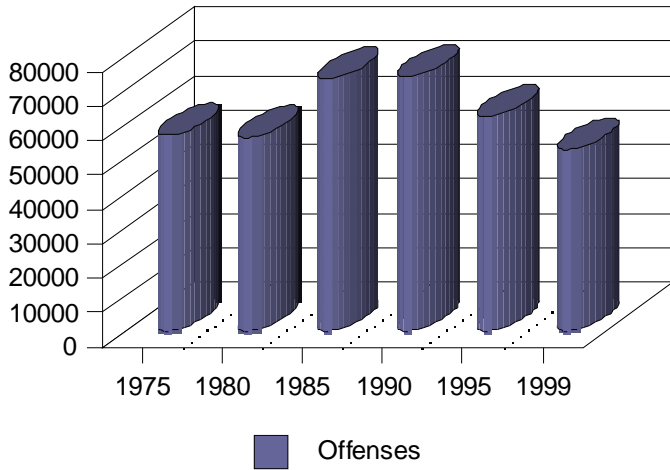
(Includes Burglary from Motor Vehicle)

The Theft offense category, which includes Burglary From a Motor Vehicle, has the highest number of reported crimes - more than 60% of the property crime total, and over 50% of the crime index total. 1974 reflects the largest percent increase of 21.1% over 1973. The largest percent decrease occurred in 1992 reflecting an 11.0% decrease from 1991.



During 1999, a total of 327,422 theft offenses was reported, reflecting a 7.0% decrease from the 352,170 offenses reported in 1998.

Motor Vehicle Theft



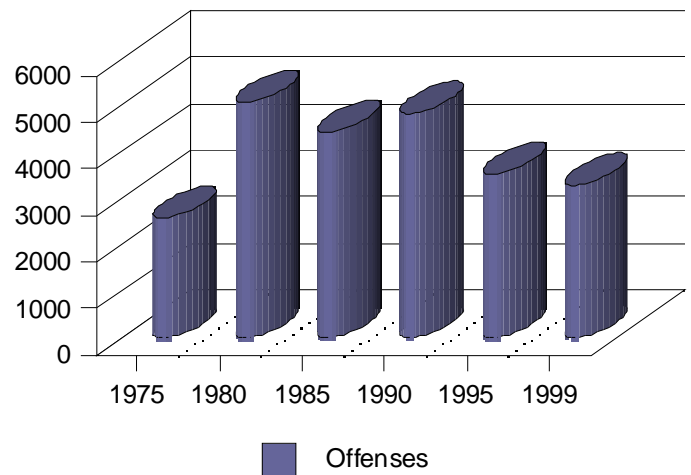
Motor Vehicle Theft offenses peaked in 1986 with a total of 77,557 offenses reported. 1984 showed the largest percent increase with 15.2% when compared to 1983, while 1987 reflected the largest decrease of 19.1% when compared to 1986. Motor vehicle thefts have decreased each year from 1992 through 1999, with the exception of 1994, which reflected a 1.0% increase in offenses reported.

During 1999, a total of 52,561 motor vehicle theft offenses was reported, reflecting a 3.6% decrease when compared to the 54,504 offenses reported in 1998.

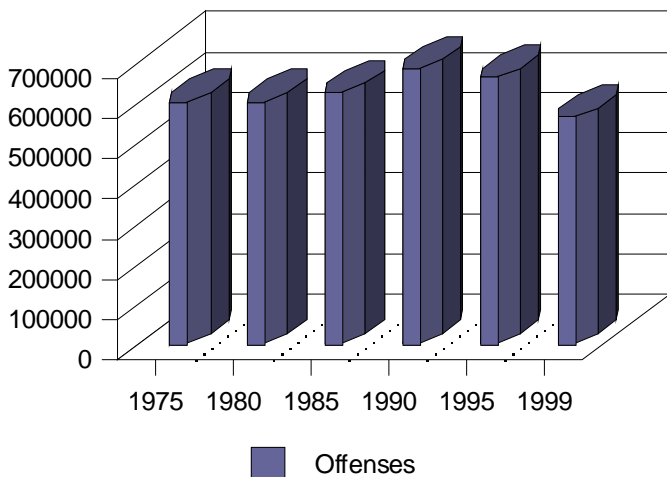
Arson

The largest number of Arson offenses occurred in 1988, with a total of 5,241. The largest percent increase occurred in 1980 with a 52.6% increase from 1979. The largest percent decrease occurred in 1982 with a 21.5% decrease from 1981. The number of arson offenses reported has decreased each year from 1989 through 1999, with the exception of 1994 and 1996.

During 1999, a total of 3,293 offenses was reported, reflecting a 2.6% decrease from the 3,381 offenses reported in 1998.



Crime Index Total



Crime Index Total offenses consists of Murder, Criminal Sexual Assault, Robbery, Aggravated Assault/Battery, Burglary, Theft, Motor Vehicle Theft and Arson. The largest number of total crime index offenses occurred in 1991 with a total 707,874. The largest percent increase occurred in 1974 with a 17.2% increase from 1973. The largest percent decrease occurred in 1992 with a 9.1% decrease from 1991.

During 1999, a total of 560,536 crime index offenses was reported, reflecting a 7.8% decrease from the 608,091 offenses reported in 1998.

CRIME TRENDS

Violent Crimes/Property Crimes

To provide useful comparisons of offense totals and rates among different types of jurisdictions in Illinois, we have added various regional charts to aid in analysis. These include the following:

State Totals. The state total includes data reported by sheriffs' offices, police departments, colleges and universities, and the Secretary of State's Office.

Downstate Totals. The downstate totals consist of the state total minus Chicago Police Department.

Chicago Police Department Totals. This total consists of the Chicago Police Department data.

Cook County Totals. This total consists of Cook County data.

• **Suburban Cook County Totals.** This total consists of all Cook County data minus Chicago Police Department data.

• **Collar Counties Total.** This total consists of data reported by sheriffs' offices, police departments, colleges and universities in DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry, and Will Counties.

• **Urban Counties Total.** This total consists of data reported by sheriffs' offices, police departments, colleges and universities in the following counties:
