The newly created cannabis and drug paraphernalia I-UCR codes provided in the September 26 update have been approved. If not unduly burdensome, it is suggested that codes be modified to the new codes for applicable offenses dating back to July 29 to ensure accurate reporting. The changes to reporting guidelines as a result of the decriminalization of certain offenses can be confusing. Examples are provided below to assist in application of the new I-UCR offense codes and reporting guidelines. The correct I-UCR code follows each offense or violation, as well as how the incident should be reported on the Monthly Index Crime collection form. The offense(s) to be reported are also underlined in the examples.

Suspect is in possession of 8 grams of cannabis (1814) and a one-hitter pipe (2171). REPORT: Nothing

Suspect is in <u>possession of 40 grams of cannabis (1810)</u>. REPORT: one (1) Cannabis Control Act (CCA) arrest

Suspect is in <u>possession of 40 grams of cannabis (1810)</u> and a <u>bong (2170)</u>. REPORT: one (1) Cannabis Control Act (CCA) arrest, and one (1) Drug Paraphernalia Act arrest

Suspect #1 is in possession of 8 grams of cannabis (1814) and Suspect #2 is in <u>possession</u> of a one-hitter pipe (2170). REPORT: one (1) Drug Paraphernalia Act arrest

Suspect #1 is in <u>possession of 40 grams of cannabis (1810)</u> and a <u>bong (2170)</u>, Suspect #2 is in possession of 6 grams of cannabis (1814) and a one-hitter pipe (2171). REPORT: one (1) Cannabis Control Act (CCA) arrest and one (1) Drug Paraphernalia Act arrest.

Suspect #1 is in possession of 40 grams of cannabis (1810) and a bong (2170), Suspect #2 is in possession of 120 grams of cannabis (1813). REPORT: two (1) Cannabis Control Act (CCA) arrests and one (1) Drug Paraphernalia Act arrest.
