

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
FOR AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READERS
BETWEEN
THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
AND THE ILLINOIS STATE POLICE**

This Second Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement (the “Agreement”), for the Automated License Plate Readers, is entered into between the Illinois Department of Transportation (“IDOT”), an Illinois state agency, and the Illinois State Police (“ISP”), also an Illinois state agency, collectively referred to as the “Parties,” and individually referred to as “Party.”

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2022, ISP and IDOT entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement for Automated License Plate Readers (“Agreement”), providing funding not to exceed \$22,500,000.00 through December 31, 2025.

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2024, ISP and IDOT entered into the First Amendment to the Agreement, providing an additional not to exceed amount of \$7,000,000.00 in funding for a total funding amount not to exceed \$29,500,000.00 and extended the term of the Agreement to December 15, 2027.

WHEREAS, ISP has requested an additional not to exceed amount of \$10,667,400.00 in funding for the Agreement to assist with completing projects previously identified and for future maintenance and hardware replacements for fiscal years 2027 and 2028 and extend the term of the Agreement to December 15, 2028 in order to use the additional funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, terms and conditions contained herein, the Parties agree to amending the Agreement as follows:

1. Article I, Section 1.6 shall be amended by striking “December 31, 2027” and inserting “December 15, 2028”. Section 1.6 shall now read as follows:

1.6 The terms of this Agreement shall be in effect through December 15, 2028.

2. Article IV, Section 4.1 shall be amended by striking “\$29,500,000.00” and inserting “\$40,167,400.00”. Section 4.1 shall now read as follows:

4.1 Subject to appropriation, ISP shall receive State Road Funds not to exceed a total of \$40,167,400.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary under this Agreement for ownership, installation, operation, and maintenance of the ALPR Systems subject to this Article IV.

3. Article IV, Section 4.2.5 shall be added and shall now read as follows:

4.2.5 Sixth Distribution: ISP may request no later than March 1, 2026, a lump sum not to exceed \$10,667,400.00 for costs associated with the ownership, installation, operation, and maintenance of ALPR Systems for all of the counties listed under the Expressway Camera Act. Distribution of the allocated funds will be completed in a manner consistent with the memorandum attached hereto

as Exhibit A.

4. All other provisions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect and are fully incorporated in this Second Amendment.

5. The individual officers, agents, and employees of ISP and IDOT who have executed this First Amendment do hereby individually represent and warrant that they have full power and lawful authority to execute this First Amendment and to cause the transactions contemplated hereunder to be performed on behalf of and in the name of their respective agencies.
