

DIVISION OF INTERNAL INVESTIGATION

2022 ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT

In 2022, the Division of Internal Investigation (DII) opened 129 cases of Illinois State Police employee misconduct. In 44 investigations completed by DII, 10 employees received discipline and of those 1 resigned prior to discipline being served, 3 were exonerated, 4 were not sustained, and 27 cases are still open. Cases of less serious transgressions (85) were referred to the employee's division to investigate.

In 2022, DII opened 88 cases of employee misconduct reported by other agencies under the purview of the Governor. Of those cases investigated by DII, 5 were administratively closed, 6 were declined by the prosecutor, 14 were not sustained, and 7 were unfounded. There are 56 cases still open.

In 2022, 1011 background investigations were completed for ISP applicants and for criminal justice agencies under the Governor's purview.
