

DIVISION OF INTERNAL INVESTIGATION

2020 ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT

In 2020, the Division of Internal Investigation (DII) opened 159 cases of Illinois State Police employee misconduct. In 68 investigations completed by DII, 19 employees received discipline and of those 4 resigned prior to discipline being served, 4 were exonerated, 4 were not sustained, 2 were administratively closed, 2 were unfounded and 37 cases are still open. Cases of less serious transgressions (91) were referred to the employee's division to investigate.

In 2020, DII opened 81 cases of employee misconduct reported by other agencies under the purview of the Governor. Of those cases investigated by DII, 1 was closed due to a lack of evidence, 1 was administratively closed, 3 were declined by the prosecutor, 8 were not sustained and 2 were unfounded. There are 66 cases still open.

In 2020, 903 background investigations were completed for ISP applicants and for criminal justice agencies under the Governor's purview. An additional 158 criminal history checks were completed for the ISP and criminal justice agencies.
