POLICY

- II.A. To help foster communications, a free flow of information will exist within the Department.
- II.B. The Department will disseminate information to employees of the Department by, but not limited to, the following methods:
 - II.B.1. Code in-service briefings
 - II.B.2. Command meetings
 - II.B.3. Commanding Operational Policing Strategies (COPS)
 - II.B.4. Directives distributed via automated systems
 - II.B.5. E-mail notes/messages
 - II.B.6. General Orders
 - II.B.7. Illinois Wireless Information Network (IWIN) messages
 - II.B.8. ISP Intranet
 - II.B.9. Law Enforcement Agencies Data System (LEADS) administrative messages
 - II.B.10. Memoranda/letters/special mailings
 - II.B.11. Newsletters
 - II.B.12. Shift summary/briefings messages
 - II.B.13. Zone/Troop/Bureau/Laboratory staff meetings
- II.C. Commanders/managers/supervisors are responsible for ensuring appropriate dissemination methods are used.
