ORG-002, ILLINOIS STATE POLICE OFFICER**

I. POLICY

The Illinois State Police (ISP) will assign general and specific duties to the officers of the Department.

II. PROCEDURES

An ISP officer will:

- II.A. Perform the statutory obligations established for an officer.
- II.B. Comply with rules and regulations established by the Director and the officer's respective chain-of-command.
- II.C. Maintain a working knowledge for the enforcement of current and newly enacted local, state, and federal statutes, as well as the Governor's Executive Orders and Department/Division directives and general orders.
- II.D. Aid the prosecutor in the preparation of cases and, when required, present credible and truthful testimony to the court.
- II.E. Take appropriate action in all cases where it is in the interest of public welfare and safety.
- II.F. Exercise discretionary judgment in an equitable and appropriate manner within the policies, rules, regulations, and guidelines established by department and division directives.
- II.G. Render assistance to distressed persons and provide guidance and direction when requested, to include appropriate medical/fire response and requests for vehicular services, i.e., tow services.
- II.H. Maintain a physical appearance that is commensurate with the favorable image of the Department (see ISP directives PER-004, "Dress and Grooming," and PER-045, "Wellness Program").
- II.I. Perform duties required by the officer's assignment.
