I. POLICY

The Illinois State Police (ISP) will:

- I.A. Provide adequate and continuous leadership.
- I.B. Delegate the proper authority to those in exempt rank.

II. AUTHORITY

20 ILCS 2610, Illinois State Police Act

- III. DEFINITIONS
 - III.A. Exempt Rank rank appointed by the Director of the ISP, not under the jurisdiction of the Illinois State Police Merit Board promotional process.
 - III.B. Permanent Rank rank achieved through the promotional process.

IV. PURPOSE

In order to provide adequate and continuous leadership, the Director may appoint sworn ISP officers to exempt ranks and delegate authority to those positions.

V. PROCEDURES

- V.A. The Director may appoint sworn officers to the following ranks:
 - V.A.1. First Deputy Director
 - V.A.2. Colonel/Deputy Director
 - V.A.3. Lieutenant Colonel/Assistant Deputy Director
 - V.A.4. Major/Regional Commander
- V.B. Officers appointed to an exempt rank will wear the corresponding rank insignia in accordance with ISP Directive EQP-007, "Uniforms."
- V.C. Officers appointed to an exempt rank may be removed from the position at the discretion of the Director. Officers removed from an exempt rank will revert to their permanent rank.
- V.D. The Director's Office shall disseminate the appointment of sworn officers to exempt ranks to all department personnel.
