



Verification of Identity
Private Information Requested
Freedom of Information Act
Pursuant to: 5 ILCS 140/1 et. seq.

Purpose: The General Assembly has adopted a public policy for the State of Illinois to allow access by all persons to public records in order to promote transparency and accountability while protecting against an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Accordingly, when a person requests records of which they are the subject that would be considered “Private Information” as defined by the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/2(c-5)), the Illinois State Police must verify the identity of the requestor.

Instructions: This form must be completed by anyone requesting “Private Information,” which would otherwise be exempt under either 5 ILCS 140/7 or 5 ILCS 140/7.5 and returned to the:

The person completing this form must:

- Be the subject, or the parent or legal guardian of the subject, of the records requested; and
- Waive their right to privacy as it relates to the release of such records.
