

Illinois State Police Office of Firearms Safety CCL Appeal Requirements/Checklist

Firearms Prohibitor – CCLRB Denial Pursuant to: 430 LCS 66/87(a)

<u>Instructions:</u> If your Firearm Concealed Carry License (CCL) application was denied based upon a determination of the Concealed Carry Licensing Review Board (CCLRB), you are not permitted to obtain a CCL unless you receive relief from the courts. You are NOT required to appeal at this time; however, when you do so, the information listed below must be provided:

You are required to file your appeal with the circuit court in writing in the county of your residence for a hearing upon such denial, revocation, or seizure. Please refer to 430 ILCS 66/87(a) for additional information.

For additional information regarding filing such an appeal, please contact the circuit clerk's office for the county in which you reside.

<u>Please Note:</u> If the circuit court grants your appeal, please provide a certified copy of the court record or court order so your CCL can be reinstated. No action will be taken without a certified copy from the court.
