29	<i>(Transportation vehicles should have forward and rear facing exterior cameras.)</i> Cameras must include recording capability with 64 GB or better storage capability.	√	
30	<i>(Transportation vehicles should have physical locking barriers separating the driving cabin from cargo compartment.)</i>	√	
31	<i>(Reinforced locking devices should be installed on all exterior doors.)</i>		√
32	<i>(Transportation vehicles should have reinforced or no side windows.)</i>	√	
38	<i>(The transporting organization should provide documentation on policies and procedures for dealing with crashes, ambushes, inclement weather, and other security related events.)</i>	√	
39	<i>(When transporting cannabis products, two persons (a driver and assistant) should be present.)</i>	√	
40	<i>(The vehicle cannot be left unattended when cannabis is present in the vehicle.)</i>	√	
41	<i>(The transporting organization should provide documentation on policies and procedures for dealing with errors or discrepancies in accepting or delivering product.)</i>	√	
42	<i>(Should the transportation organization transport cash payments, the organization should develop a security plan addressing such transportation. The Security Plan should include procedures relating to acceptance of the cash, safe storage, and record keeping.)</i>	√
