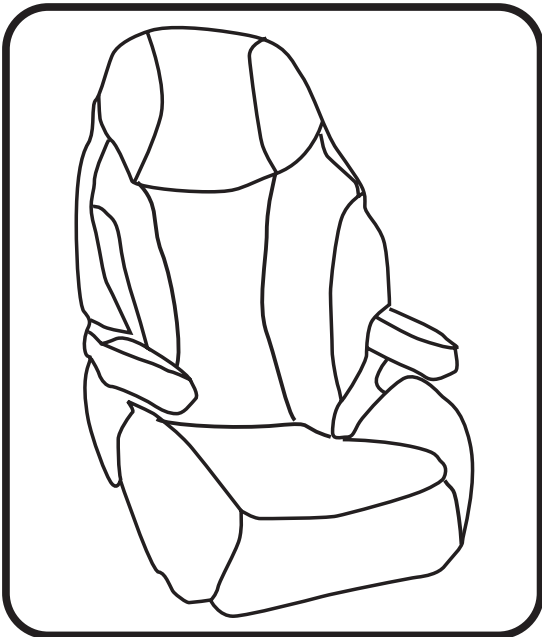
Which car seat is right for you?

The safest seating position is always in the back seat.

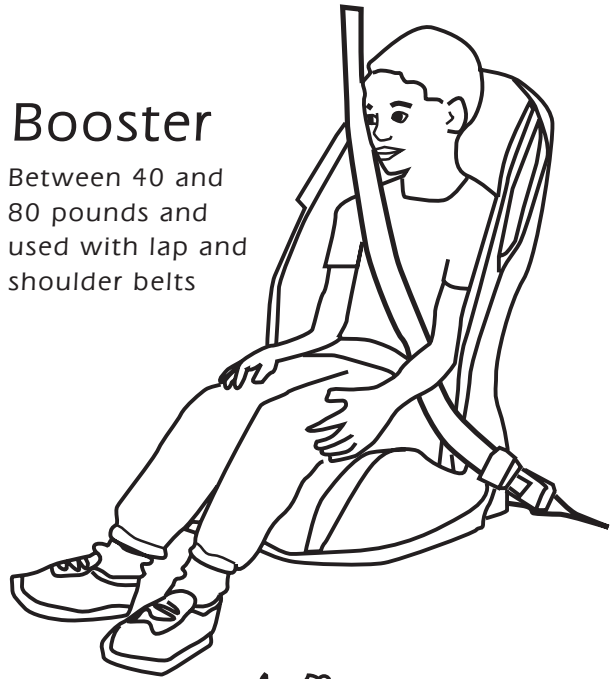
Rear Facing Infant

From birth to (2) two years old, unless they are 40 lbs. or 40 inches tall



Booster

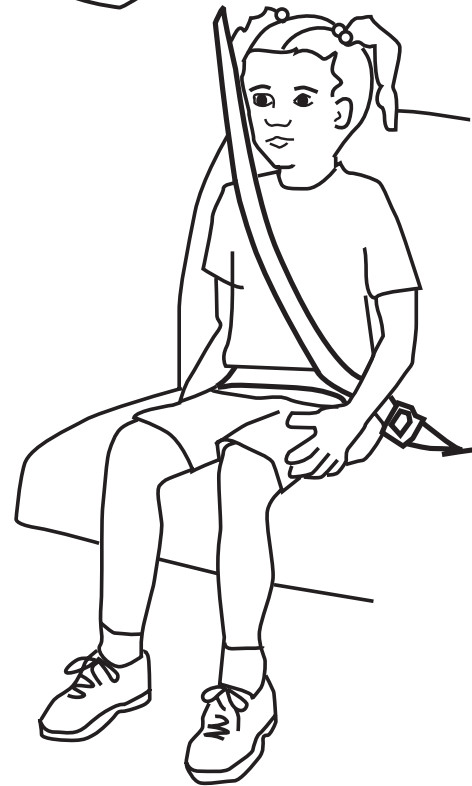
Between 40 and 80 pounds and used with lap and shoulder belts



Convertible

Rear facing - from birth to 2 (two) years old or 40 lbs.

Forward facing - after 2 years old or over 40 lbs.



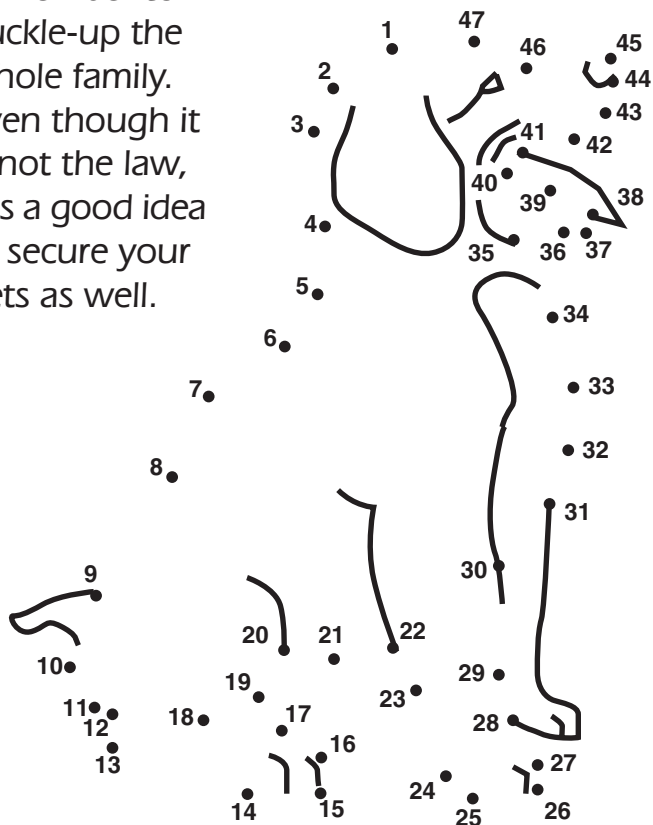

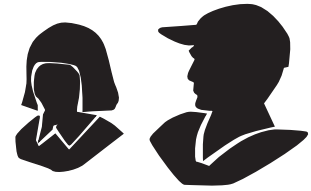
Kids Aren't Cargo

STOP! -- Never ride in the back of a pickup truck!

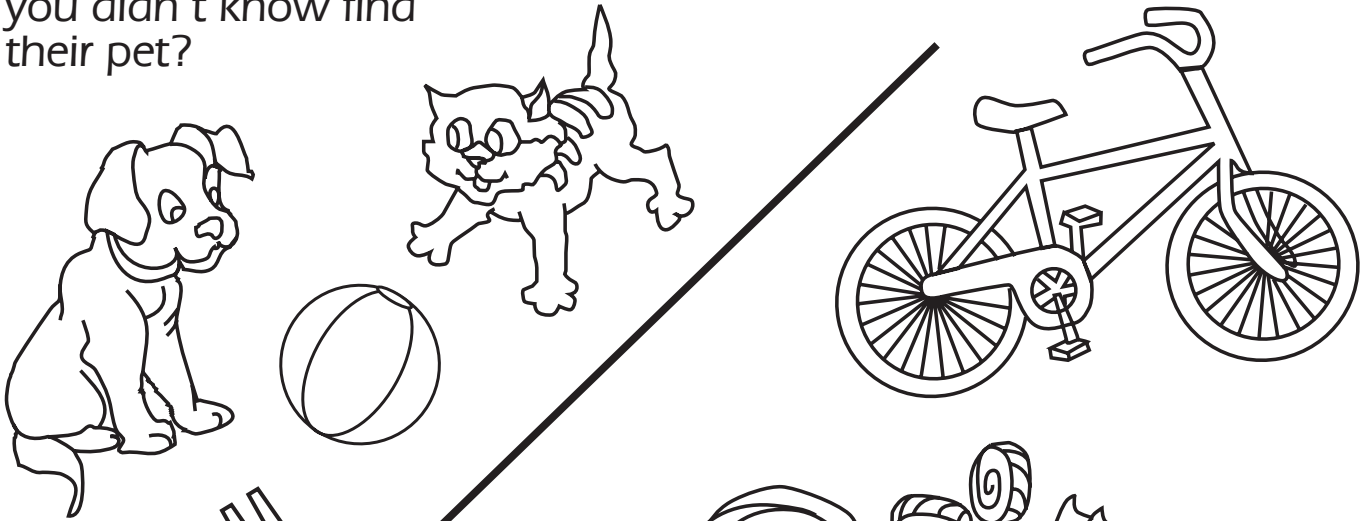
