

The safest seating position is always in the back seat.

Rear Facing Infant

From birth to (2) two years old, unless they are 40 lbs. or 40 inches tall





Rear facing - from birth to 2 (two) years old or 40 lbs.
Forward facing – after 2 years old or over 40 lbs.

80 pounds and over 8 years and older







