### I. POLICY

| The Illinois State Police (ISP) will provide all officers with electronic access to ISP Legal Bulletins.

### II. RESPONSIBILITIES

| II.A. The Division of Administration is responsible for providing access to the ISP Legal Bulletins.

| II.B. Each officer is responsible for accessing and reading the ISP Legal Bulletins to stay abreast of recent court decisions affecting law enforcement.

| **NOTE:** Information contained in the ISP Legal Bulletins is used in each promotional examination.

### III. PROCEDURES

| III.A. Officers shall access current and past issues of the ISP Legal Bulletins by accessing LMS at <http://lms.ileas.isp.state.il.us>.

| III.B. Information in an ISP Legal Bulletin that is contradictory to ISP policy, rule, or procedure will not immediately change any existing policy, rule, or procedure. Officers discovering a contradiction with current ISP directives should notify the Policy Development Section through their chain-of-command.

| III.C. Officers will use knowledge gained from the ISP Legal Bulletins as a guide for action in those areas where an ISP directive, rule, or procedure does not exist.
