

ILLINOIS STATE POLICE DIRECTIVE ENF-001, EAVESDROPPING

I. POLICY

The Illinois State Police (ISP) will use and enforce provisions in the Illinois Compiled Statutes relating to eavesdropping.

II. PROCEDURES

II.A. The Commander, Statewide Investigations Support Coordinator, Division of Operations, in conjunction with the Commander of Training, ISP Academy, Division of Administration, will establish and maintain necessary courses of training related to eavesdropping and eavesdropping devices.

II.B. The Investigative Support Coordinator, Statewide Investigations Support Command, will:

II.B.1. Review all eavesdropping training and arrange for necessary modifications to keep any eavesdropping program current and effective.

II.B.2. Maintain the Reference Manual for Eavesdrop Applications (the manual), manual ISP 4-198 (this manual is available from the ISP Document Library at <http://maphome/documentlibrary/>) and, as such, will:

II.B.2.a. Provide clarification and interpretation of eavesdropping procedures

II.B.2.b. Ensure compliance with eavesdropping procedures

II.B.2.c. Review proposals for new eavesdropping procedures

II.B.2.d. Develop interim eavesdropping procedures to enable the Department to use new eavesdropping legislation in a timely manner

II.B.2.e. Ensure eavesdropping procedures continue to satisfy all legal requirements

II.B.2.f. Provide all investigative units with a copy of the manual

II.C. All personnel engaging in eavesdropping activity will follow the procedures set forth in the Reference Manual for Eavesdrop Applications.
