I. POLICY

The Illinois State Police (ISP) will provide crime scene, polygraph, and forensic diagramming and animation services to all law enforcement agencies in the state.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES

Crime scene services include, but are not limited to:

- II.A. Collection and preservation of physical evidence
- II.B. Forensic art
- II.C. Forensic mapping
- II.D. Photography
- II.E. Polygraph examinations
- II.F. Sketch of the scene
- II.G. Two and three-dimensional diagrams and animations of crash and crime scenes
- II.H. Three-dimensional laser scene scanning
- II.I. Bloodstain pattern analysis
- II.J. Bullet Trajectory Analysis
